**Order Granting Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on Promissory Note**

The Court considered *The Plan’s “Traditional” Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Against Defendant NuView Molecular Pharmaceuticals, Inc. for Failure to Pay Promissory Note* (filed March 27, 2020) (“Motion”), filed on March 27, 2020 by John Bisnar, in his capacity as Trustee for JPB IK Plan, assignee of Interstate Restoration, LLC’s claims (“Bisnar”), against Defendant NuView Molecular Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (“Defendant NMP”).

The Motion is GRANTED.

Bisnar recovers from Defendant NMP the amount of ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~, plus interest

on this amount from this day forward, at the rate of ~~24%~~ **18% per year, as required by Texas Finance Code section 304.002.** along with costs.
